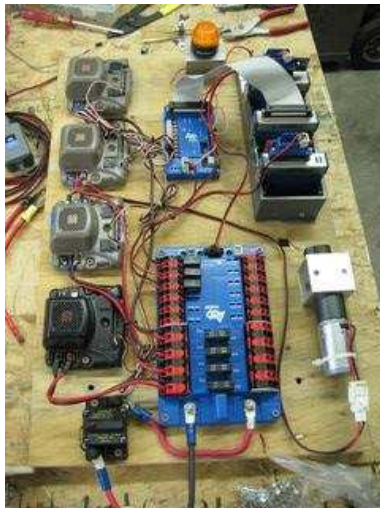


Team Tators Newsletter

October 2011

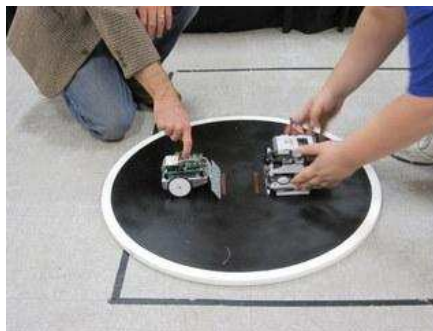
This month the Tators worked diligently and the students were flowing with creativity to improve the robot for next season's competition.
